INSTRUCTIONAL ASSISTANT / LAB TECHNICIAN

The **Instructional Assistant (IA)** is responsible for providing instructional support to students under the direction of the Academic Coordinator and the program Instructors. The **Lab Technician** is a second level responder to user service requests (hardware and software), sets up computers for staff and students, creates and modifies computer images as necessary, and assists in the administration of a multi-server environment, including NetWare, Cisco, Linux and Windows services.

Job Duties include but are not limited to:

Instructional Assistant

- Monitor and support Cyber Defence and Cloud Administration Diploma students during independent lab time.
- Reinforce content provided by the instructor.
- Assist and monitor students in the development of their theoretical and practical skills.
- Assist in review and reinforcement of program materials assigned by the instructor.

Lab Assistant

- Monitor servers and network equipment for correct operation.
- Check and perform network services such as backups and restores, when necessary on NetWare, Linux and Windows servers.
- Assist instructors on classroom reconfiguration and cabling.
- Assist instructors with plans for the setup, distribution, updating and documentation of student and staff
 workstations; plan and implement the updating of computer images to ensure up-to-date software and patches
 are distributed in a timely, regular manner; and contribute to the IT planning process.

Requirements:

- Graduate from recognized IT program with networking, security and Microsoft infrastructure emphasis.
- 2 to 3 years' related industry experience.
- Current related certifications from a recognized industry/corporate training such as Novell, Microsoft, VMWare or Cisco is an asset.
- Teaching/training experience in adult education setting is an asset.
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills.
