Framing hammer. <i>It is recommended that students select a framing hammer with a steel handle between 16" and 18" in length with a milled face and a head weight of between 19oz to 22oz. Recommended brands: Estwing, Stanley, Dewalt.</i>	\$50.00

Speed square	\$20.00
12" nail puller	\$25.00
25' heavy duty tape measure (imperial only)	\$20.00

Lineman pliers	\$30.00
