International Funds Transfer:	For students who do not have a Canadian Bank Account Western Union GlobalPay for Students : Payment should be made via our bank transfer and online payment options platform https://student.globalpay.wu.com/geo-buyer/miotat#!/ powered by our partner Western Union Business Solutions. This service allows you to send bank transfers in the currency of your choice, so you don't have to worry about exchange rates, bank fees or funds arriving short at the College.
Visa / Mastercard / American Express:	This method is for international students only. Pay using the Payment Agreement form supplied with your offer of admission. Please note that Credit Debit cards (e.g. Visa Debit) cannot be accepted using this method. If necessary, please ensure that you have made arrangements with your bank to have your daily limit increased to cover your full payment amount.
