Health insurance for international students enrolled at Manitoba Institute of Trades and Technology is provided by MITT International Health (international.health@mitt.ca). The guard.me @ Manitoba policy includes coverage for medically necessary treatment. Should a student contract COVID-19 while in Manitoba, their medical care would be covered in line with the policy. Guard.me's coverage has not changed during this situation. As long as your guard.me policy is valid, if you become ill from COVID-19 in Manitoba, any medically necessary treatment would be covered through the guard.me @ Manitoba policy.
