Scholarships are valued at \$500 each and provide financial recognition to current MITT students who have maintained a high GPA in their MITT Post-Secondary program. These scholarships are made available by the MITT Student Awards Fund.

Number of awards: Multiple, based on annual International student enrollment numbers

To be considered for a scholarship, students must:

- 1. Complete this application form in full
- Submit an unofficial MITT transcript (accessed in your student portal), that shows a minimum of 4.0 Term GPA
- 3. Maintain good Academic standing
- 4. Be enrolled in MITT as an International, post-secondary student
- 5. Students must provide a Canadian Social Insurance Number to be eligible for this scholarship
