

# **Winnipeg Construction Association Bursary**

Established in 2024 by the Winnipeg Construction Association, this bursary supports post-secondary students in construction sector programs who are in financial need and interested in pursuing a career in the construction industry.

## Number of awards: 2 awards | Value: \$2,000 each

To be considered for the Winnipeg Construction Association Bursary, you must fill out a General Bursary application, as well as provide documents outlining the following:

#### **Personal Statement:**

Attach a document in an email to <a href="mailto:studentawards@mitt.ca">studentawards@mitt.ca</a> that describes why you chose your program, your long-term career and employment goals after graduation, and how this bursary can help make an impact in your life.

Maximum one page, double-spaced, 12-point font.

### **Eligibility Criteria:**

Selection for the awards will be based on financial need, being in good academic standing, and demonstrated interest in remaining in the construction sector in their career.

### **Applicants must:**

- 1. Be full-time, post-secondary students enrolled in one of the following programs:
  - a. Carpentry
  - b. Electrical Application
  - c. CAD Technician
  - d. Industrial Welding
  - e. Industrial Mechanic/Millwright
- 2. Must submit a personal statement
- 3. Be eligible for the MITT General Bursary and submit the application to complete the financial needs assessment

# **Exclusions:**

- This award excludes students in Continuing Education, English as a Second Language, MITT high school or students from partner high school programs.

#### **Award disbursement:**

- All awards will be applied to any outstanding MITT tuition amounts before any payments are made directly to the student.
- If a student withdraws from studies after receiving a scholarship or bursary, the student will not qualify for a refund including any scholarship or bursary portion.
