** PVSC and abuse registry clearances are only deemed valid for a maximum period of six months and must cover the entire Work Practicum duration (i.e., beyond the end date). Returning Year 2 students must submit new pre-practicum clearance documents as these are required annually.*

*** **ParaMed Placement Pass** is an approved third-party agency that handles pre-placement immunization and clearance verification for MITT students.*

Respondus Lockdown Browser

Students may be required to complete assessments on the MyLearning platform using Respondus LockDown Browser (a free online application), which must be installed on a laptop before testing.
