



Manitoba Home Builders Association Bursary

Established by the Manitoba Home Builders Association (MHBA) these bursaries support post-secondary students enrolled full-time in MITT's Carpentry and Electrical Applications programs. One recipient from each program will be selected per year.

Number of awards: 2 awards | Value: \$1000

Eligibility Criteria:

To be eligible for the award, applicants must:

- Be enrolled full-time as a post-secondary student at MITT
- Be enrolled in either the Carpentry or Electrical Applications Program
- Demonstrate financial need
- Have an interest in the field of residential construction

Application Process

Applicants must submit the following:

- A completed award application form
- A brief personal statement (max. 1 page, double-spaced) describing your interest in the field of residential construction, as well as your long-term career objectives and intended employment goals following graduation

Selection Process

Applications will be reviewed and selected based on financial need and the personal statement. One recipient from each program will be selected.

Award Disbursement

- Award funds will first be applied directly to the students' account to cover any outstanding tuition or fees. If this creates a credit on their account, the student may request a refund for the remaining balance
- If a recipient withdraws from the program before the award is disbursed, they will no longer be eligible for the bursary

Renewal & Reapplication

The award is non-renewable; however, previous recipients may reapply in subsequent years if they continue to meet eligibility criteria.
