GLOSSARY OF TERMS

Term	Definition
Academic Schedule	A schedule of important events that occur in an academic year.
Convocation	A formal ceremony at which diplomas and certificates are conferred.
Graduation	Official recognition that a student has successfully completed all the requirements of a program and earned their credential.
Student Success (Reading) Week	For most programs, no classes are scheduled in week 8 of each 15-week term. Also referred to as Break/Reading Week.
Intersession	A short break between standard academic terms. No classes scheduled.
