MITT is proud to offer entrance scholarships to women entering fields of study and career paths where women have previously been underrepresented. Women who apply for any of the September 2021 trades programs listed below will automatically be considered for a Women in Trades entrance scholarship.

To be considered, future students must submit an MITT program application **no later than June 30, 2021.** Recipients are selected based on grade averages from the high school Math and English scores submitted with the MITT program application.

If you are a woman considering a career in trades, apply early and get a head start on your career training!

Eligible programs:

- Automotive Service Technician
- CAD Technician
- Carpentry
- Electrical Applications
- Electronics Technician
- Industrial Mechanic/Millwright
- Industrial Welding
- Motosport Technician

Eligible Students:

- Students must be female/identify as female
- Full-time post-secondary
- Canadian citizen or permanent resident
