*\*Lab coats are required for all labs and Work Practicum. Practicum coats must be embroidered. A second, plain lab coat (about \$30–\$40) is recommended for lab use.*

*\*\*PVSC and abuse registry clearances are only deemed valid for a maximum period of six months and must cover the entire Work Practicum duration (i.e., beyond the end date).*

*\*\*\*ParaMed Placement Pass is an approved third-party agency that handles pre-placement immunization and clearance verification for MITT students. Students are responsible for service fees related to their user account. All details about immunization, testing, and clearance documents will be covered during the Placement Pass orientation, scheduled after the program begins. **Please await the Program Orientation before proceeding with any immunizations or clearance applications.***

## Respondus Lockdown Browser

Students may be required to complete assessments on the MyLearning platform using Respondus LockDown Browser (a free online application), which must be installed on a laptop before testing.

## Required Textbooks
