

Vickar Automotive Group Southern Chiefs' Organization Educational Bursary

To be considered for the Vickar Automotive Group Southern Chiefs' Organization Educational Bursary, you must fill out a Fall 2024 General Bursary application, as well as provide a word document outlining the following:

- Applicants must be active in contributing to their on-and off-campus communities and be able to provide documentation and/or demonstrate their involvement/participation. The award selection committee will use community involvement as the primary selection criteria and will take into consideration:
 - Amount of time spent each week/month in a community-based activity and total number of months/years of involvement; and
 - Type of activity and the extent of its positive community impact.
 - Examples include but are not limited to: Volunteerism, coaching/mentoring,
 culturalbased activities serving an educational and community-building role; MITT student group participation and/or leadership.
 - Consideration will also be given to students who have been, or are currently employed or volunteer in roles considered front-line or essential to covid-19 response and prevention.
 - Examples include but are not limited to: Healthcare, senior's care and social services; agriculture, food production and grocery; transportation; utilities/public works; education; other employment defined by the Province of MB/MB Health as essential may be considered.

Eligibility:

In addition to the eligibility requirements listed on the Fall 2024 General Bursary:

- Full-time, post-secondary student in an MITT program
- Excluded MITT programs are: English Language Institute, Life Long Learning, Adult Learning Centre and high school programs

- Must be a member of one of the 34 First Nations within the Southern Chiefs' Organization
- Proof of band membership is required

By submitting this application, the student agrees to the following conditions.

- The scholarship recipient consents to MITT providing the Southern Chiefs' Organization their contact information and to be contacted directly by the donor for the purposes of promoting the scholarship.
- 2) This bursary will be applied to the recipient's MITT tuition account first and will only be paid directly to a student if their MITT account has been paid in full. When tuition fees are paid by the student in installments (Rotessa), the scholarship amount will be used to reduce the amount of each payment.
